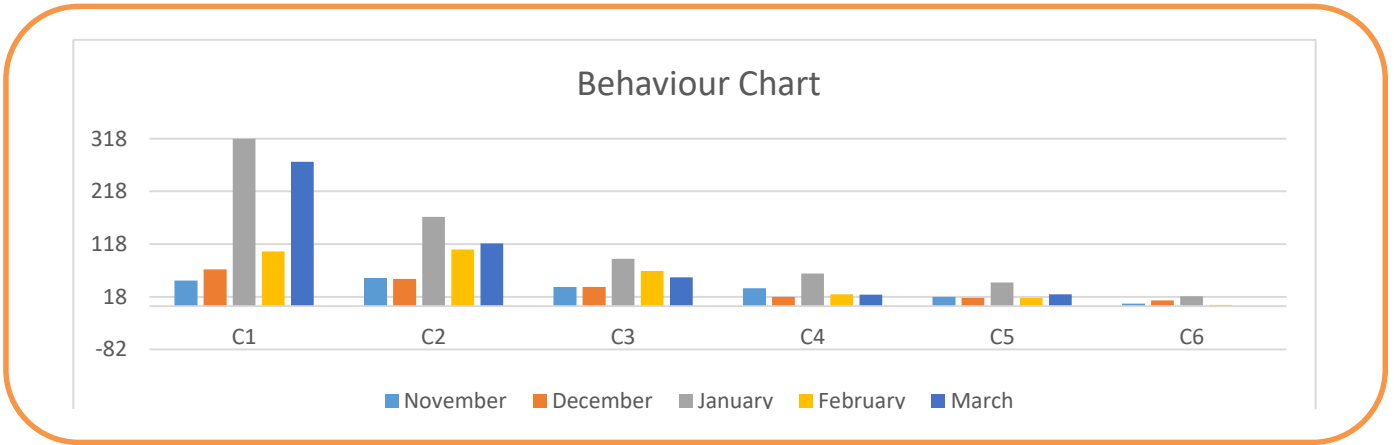

Early Years Foundation Stage

Nursery have been very busy planting summer bedding plants this week. We spent time talking about the roots, water and sunshine. We are also excited about planting some vegetable seeds and a strawberry plant.

Reception have been amazed at how big our caterpillars have grown. It will soon be time for them to begin their amazing transformation. Ask your child what is going to happen to them. Ask them about the other minibeasts that they have been learning about. They will impress you with some fabulous facts.

YEAR 1/2

Year 1 have been following on from our school trip and creating a fantastic class log showing the four seasons. They have also been creating line drawings of a brown bear, which we talked about and improved for our second attempt. In maths we have been using base 10 to make number and in literacy we have been learning the story 'We're going on a bear hunt'.

Both Year 1 and Year 2 have been learning about the creation story from different religions and what differences these have. We will be moving towards discussing our own ideas for the big questions.



YEAR 5

As part of their topic on allotments, Y5 children have been making bird feeders this week. They mixed together some lard and a special mixture of seeds and nuts that are good for birds, and put this into a polystyrene cup. They put string through the cup so that it can be hung where birds will be able to reach it. Finally, they put the mixture to set in the fridge.



YEAR 3/4

This week we have begun making swords and shields. Our trip to the Leeds Armouries really inspired us to create accurate designs with coats of arms on them. We used cardboard boxes and drew our shield onto them using a template. After this everyone used masking tape to create a design, some of them are chevrons and some of them are lines. The next step for us is to paint them with acrylic paints. In literacy we have been working hard to begin writing our adventure stories based on the popular story 'The Hodgeheg' by Dick King Smith.



YEAR 6

Year 6 have completed their SATs. It was hard but they made it! We are very proud of the attitude and commitment they have shown. The tests have now been sent for marking and the results will be released early July. **Well Done!**
