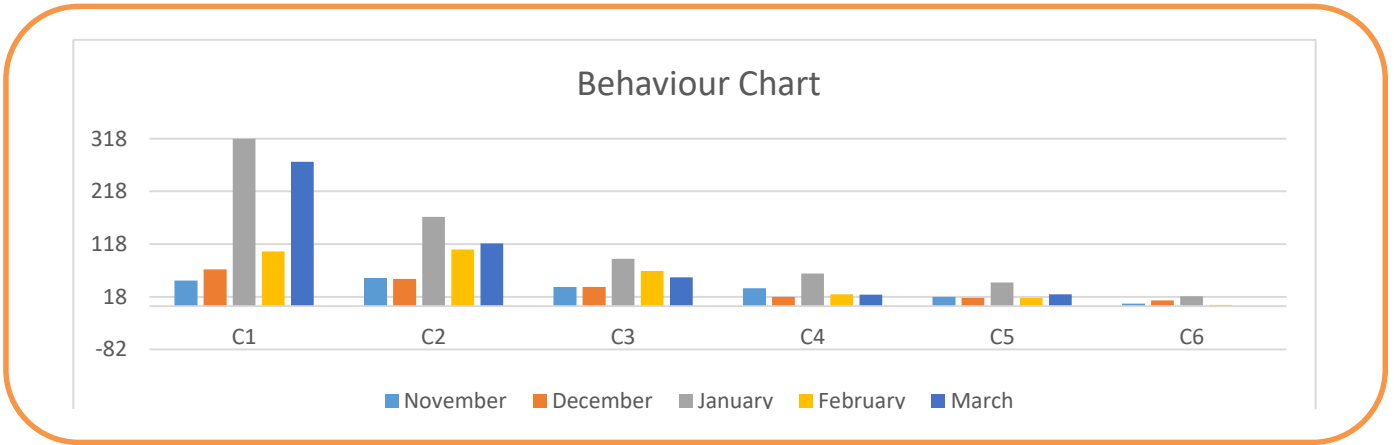

### Early Years Foundation Stage

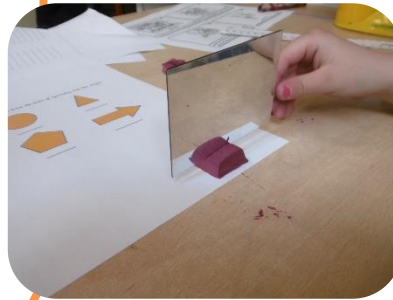
