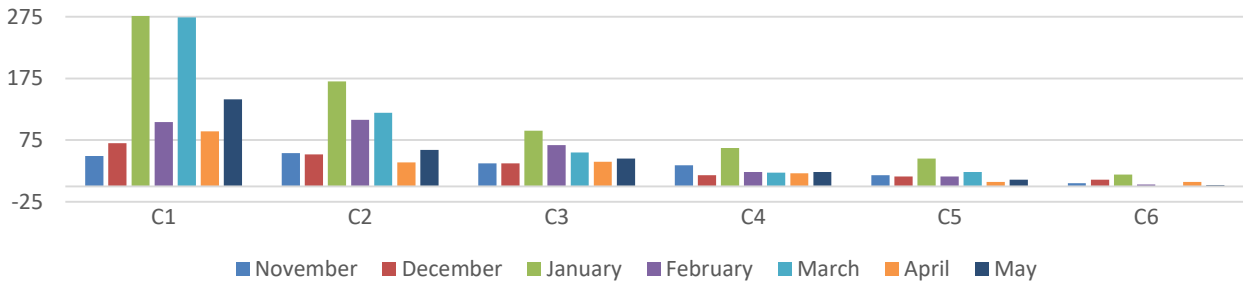

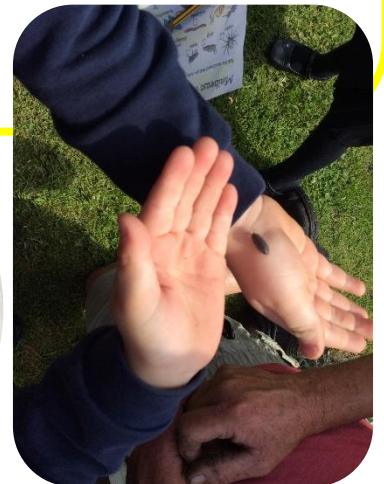
Early Years Foundation Stage
