

Early Years Foundation Stage

Nursery have been trying very hard this week practicing their early writing skills. We have explored writing and mark making using a variety of different materials. The children have enjoyed creating letter shapes and marks inside and outside the nursery. The children have written their own shopping lists and are now beginning to plan another Teddy Bear's Picnic! We have had lots of fun.

YEAR 1/2

Year two were keen to put their sewing skills into action by making bug models. They were all very focused using a running stitch to complete the model and then filled them and added detail.



YEAR 3/4

During this week's literacy lessons year 3/4 have been learning how to write a newspaper report. The subject of the report has been Harry Potter. The children had to come up with questions to ask characters during a hot seat lesson. The children have enjoyed talking and writing about details in The Harry Potter series. Their enthusiasm for the subject has resulted in some fabulous newspaper reports.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Following a serious incident elsewhere in the country we have been advised to review our absence protocols. We need to stress the importance of notifying the academy if your child is absent. In the interests of safeguarding we will be implementing the following as a matter of urgency:

- We need at least three telephone contact details for all pupils. If we do not receive notification that your child is absent we will contact you either by telephone or text. If no reply is received, we will then contact the other numbers on the list.
- If no contact can be made a member of staff may make a home visit.
- If there is no answer the school may contact the police Thank you in anticipation of your support
