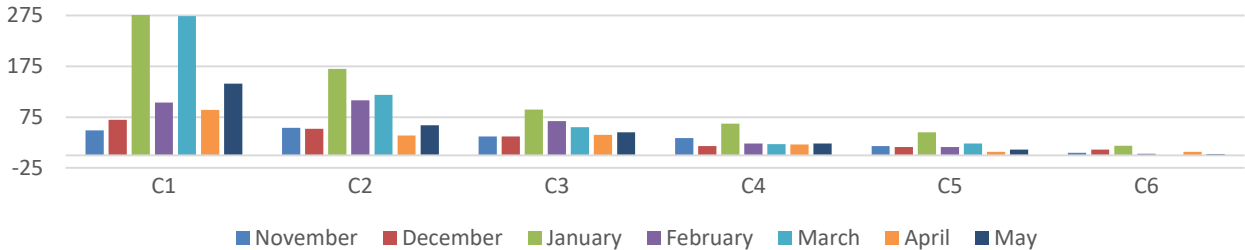

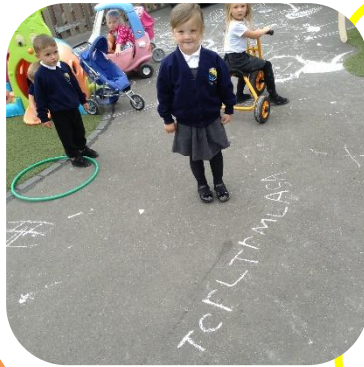

### Early Years Foundation Stage

Nursery have been trying very hard this week practicing their early writing skills. We have explored writing and mark making using a variety of different materials. ### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Following a serious incident elsewhere in the country we have been advised to review our absence protocols. **We need to stress the importance of notifying the academy if your child is absent.** In the interests of safeguarding we will be implementing the following as a matter of urgency:

- We need at least three telephone contact details for all pupils. If we do not receive notification that your child is absent we will contact you either by telephone or text. If no reply is received, we will then contact the other numbers on the list.
- If no contact can be made a member of staff may make a home visit.
- If there is no answer the school may contact the police
