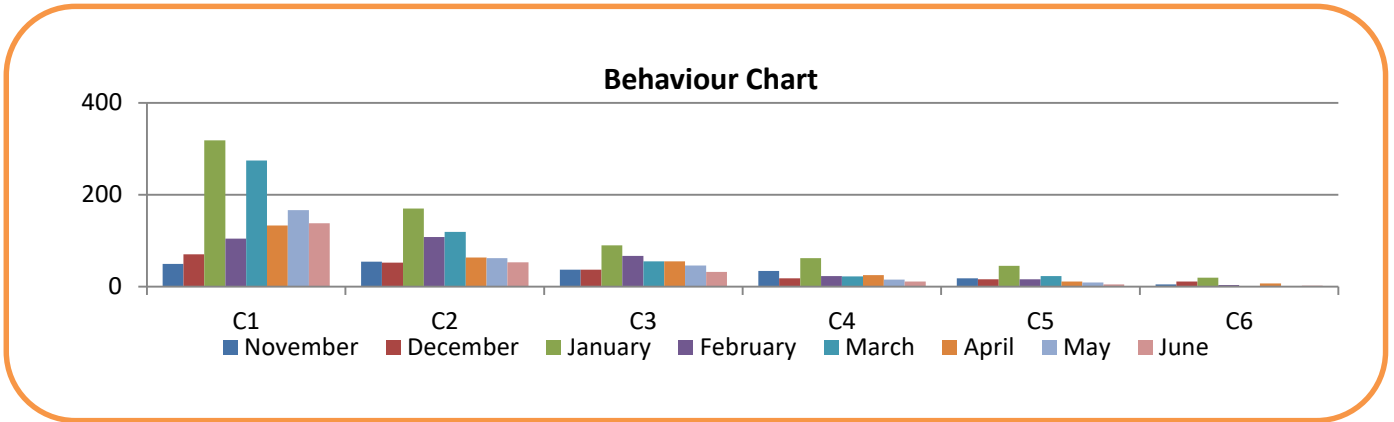

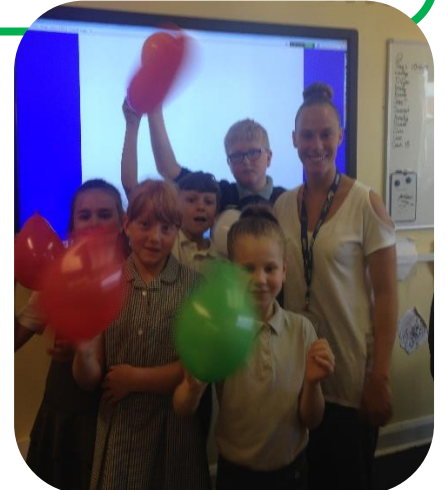
## YEAR 5
