


Year 1 and 2

We have learned all of the words and can perform them with actions in 'Talk for Writing'. Some of us have even re-told and written all of the words too!


This week Year 2 have followed instructions to make bubble mixture. They then had the opportunity to blow their bubbles that they made outside.

Early Years Foundation Stage

Nursery have been singing Humpty Dumpty and other nursery rhymes this week. We are learning to say the rhymes in the right order.

Year 3 and 4

They learned about the process of making rock, could watch it being made and were even given their own stick, which they had to roll until the correct shape was created. They also got to see how each part of the factory worked and speak to some of its staff. Did you know that the factory has been producing rock and sweets since 1911? Finally, the children were able to create their own chocolate lollies by melting liquid chocolate and letting it solidify in a mould. Scrumdiddlyumptious!
