Pupil Premium Allocation 2017/18

Pupil Premium is additional funding allocated to schools to support the learning of children who are known to be eligible for free school meals (FSM) or children who are 'looked after'. Funding is also accessible for Service families.

One of the key objectives of our pupil premium spending is to provide a wide range of extra-curricular activities to broaden children's learning experiences and to foster and develop each child's interests and talents.

With this in mind we would like to offer every child entitled to Pupil Premium a virtual allocation of £100. This allocation can be used to pay for clubs, trips and even residential visits. You can use the £100 to pay for any of these activities either in part or fully. You are also entitled to use the full allocation against one activity ie a residential visit.

Your virtual £100 is available for the academic year which runs 1st September 2017 to 31st August 2018. All you need to do is let us know you want to use your Pupil Premium Allocation. You can do this by telephoning the main office or simply writing PP Allocation and the amount you want to use on the reply slips for clubs, trips etc.

Please be assured once your allocation is spent, your child will still be included in our many varied extra-curricular activities that we subsidise.

If you feel your child is eligible for free school meals, please complete the attached application form and return to the school office where we will be happy to forward onto the Local Authority.

You can also be confident that we are committed to ensuring personal and sensitive information we hold about you and your child is kept safe, secure and confidential.
