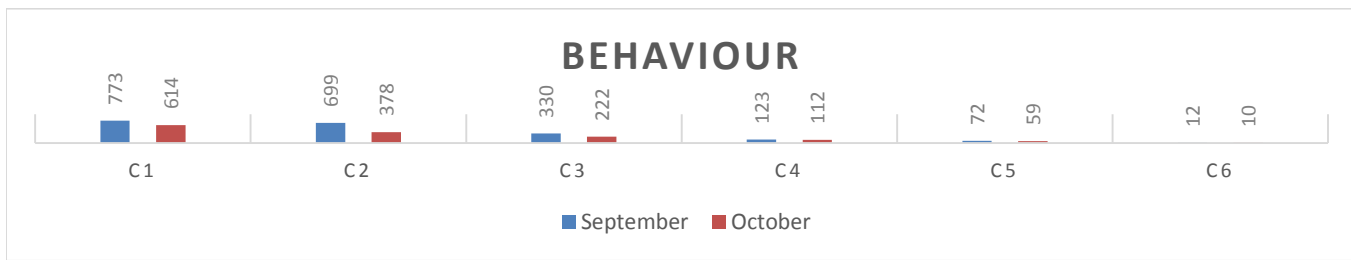

### Early Years Foundation Stage

### Year 1 and 2

#### New school library

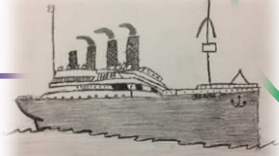
