Home Reading

Children will bring home a reading book every day. The book that your child brings home is a decodable book that they should be able to read independently using ‘special friends, Fred talk, read the word’ or ‘Fred in your head.’ Your child will also have a reading record. Please ensure they are reading at least 3 times a week and record each time your child has read in their reading record. Every Friday the children who have read 3 times or more receive a treat. When your child has read 50 times and then 100 / 200 / 300 times they will be able to visit our Weelsbystones Shop and choose a book to keep!

Please ensure your child brings their book and reading record in their book bag everyday. Books will be changed every Monday.

School Uniform

It is the school's policy that all children wear school uniform. This is:

- A blue sweatshirt or cardigan, ideally with the academy logo.
- A white polo shirt.
- Black or grey trousers, pinafore or skirt.
- Sensible, black footwear.

PE kit is a white t-shirt and black shorts (blue or black joggers for outdoors) and trainers. All children should bring a change of clothes for PE. They should not come to school in their PE kit.
