Throughout Reception, we will use the online system ARC to record your child's learning and to share letters / messages.

If you have not already done so, please share your email address with your child's class teacher. You will then be emailed an activation link to create Login details. After you create a Login, you will be able to log on and keep track of your child's learning and development. A massive advantage of this system is that you, as parents can be involved by adding your own comments to our entries, and you can also upload any 'wow' moments your child has outside of school.
